Committees for Realtors® and Affiliates

Affiliate – Provides and reviews services to Realtor® members while striving to strengthen Affiliate involvement. Provides programs which will enhance the social aspects and comradeship among Association members (meets 2nd Friday at 9:00 a.m.)

Communication/Technology Forum – Enhances and strengthens the Association's communications objectives and plan with its members, the media and the public. Responsible for identifying technology members use and explore ways to enhance those technologies for daily business. The committee will look to provide training and/or informal working groups to members looking for ways of using technology (meets at call of chairman)

Consumer Outreach – In addition to affirmatively promoting fair and equal access to homeownership, this committee gets out in the communities we serve and lifts them up with community service. (meets 2nd Tuesday)

Legislative Affairs – Educates the membership of all the issues of a political/legislative nature that directly impact their business. Constitution/Bylaws/Policy – Reviews and amends the Association's governing documents as directed by the leadership and/or membership. (meets at call of chairman)

Grievance – Reviews ethical complaints from members and the public as well as Arbitration requests from the Broker/Mgr. companies to determine if further investigation via Professional Standards hearing needs to be set up. Must be a Realtor® for at least two years. (meets at call of chairman)

Nominating – Searches, screens and nominates qualified members to serve as leadership on the Board of Directors. (meets at call of chairman)

Norma L. Good Scholarship – Reviews and awards scholarships to Realtor® members of SCAR for obtaining NAR Designations/Certifications or broker's licensure courses (meets at call of chairman)

Professional Services/Networking – Reviews, expands and monitors Realtor® education offerings. Provides programs and services to the membership in presenting our annual R-day in October. (Meets 2nd Monday)

Professional Standards – Conducts all hearings of complaints/arbitration requests forwarded from the Grievance Committee per the rules of the NAR Code of Ethics and Arbitration manual. Appointees to this committee must have first serve a 3-year term on the Grievance Committee. (meets at call of chairman)
